What is a Sustainable Profession?

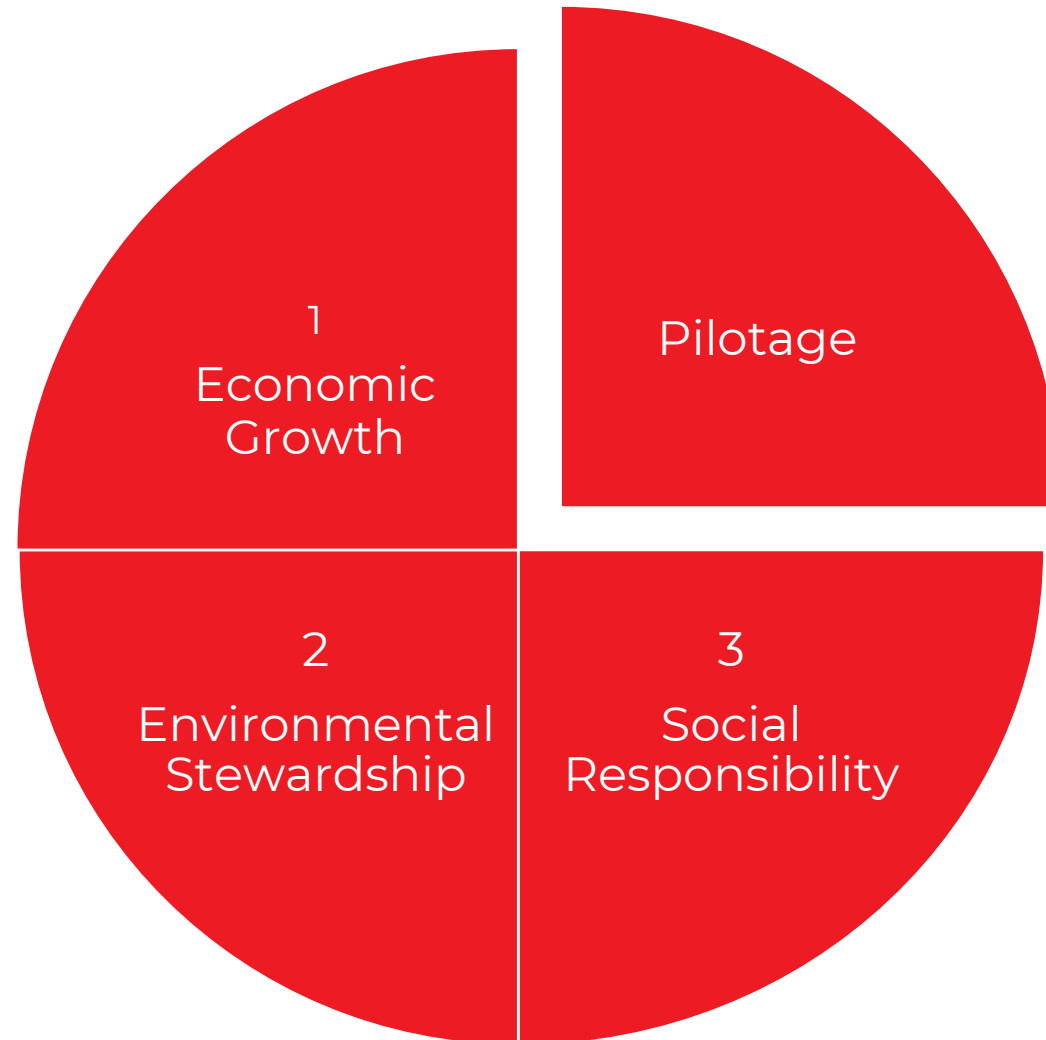


A sustainable profession is one that addresses the current needs without compromising the ability of future generations.

It balances economic growth, environmental stewardship and social responsibility.

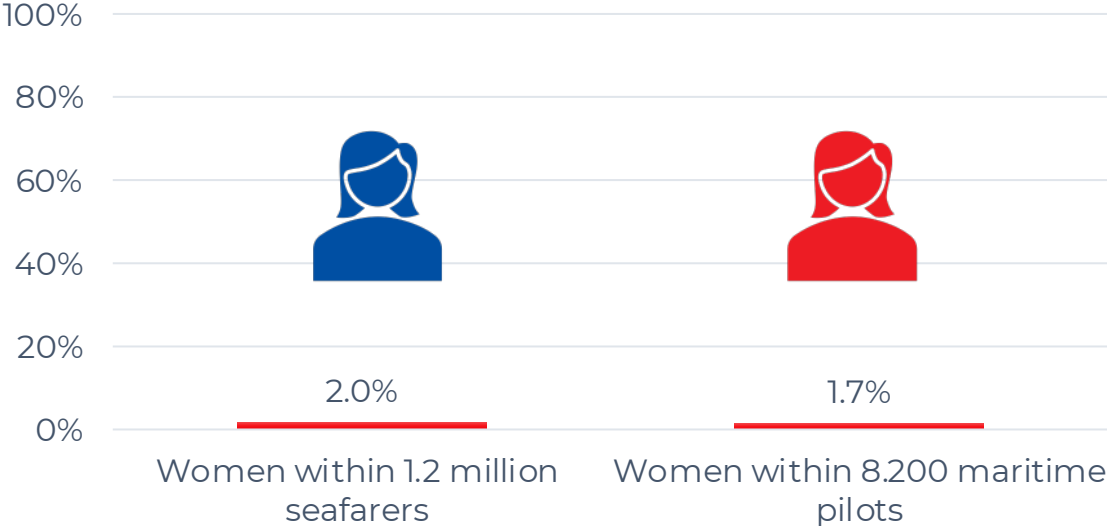
