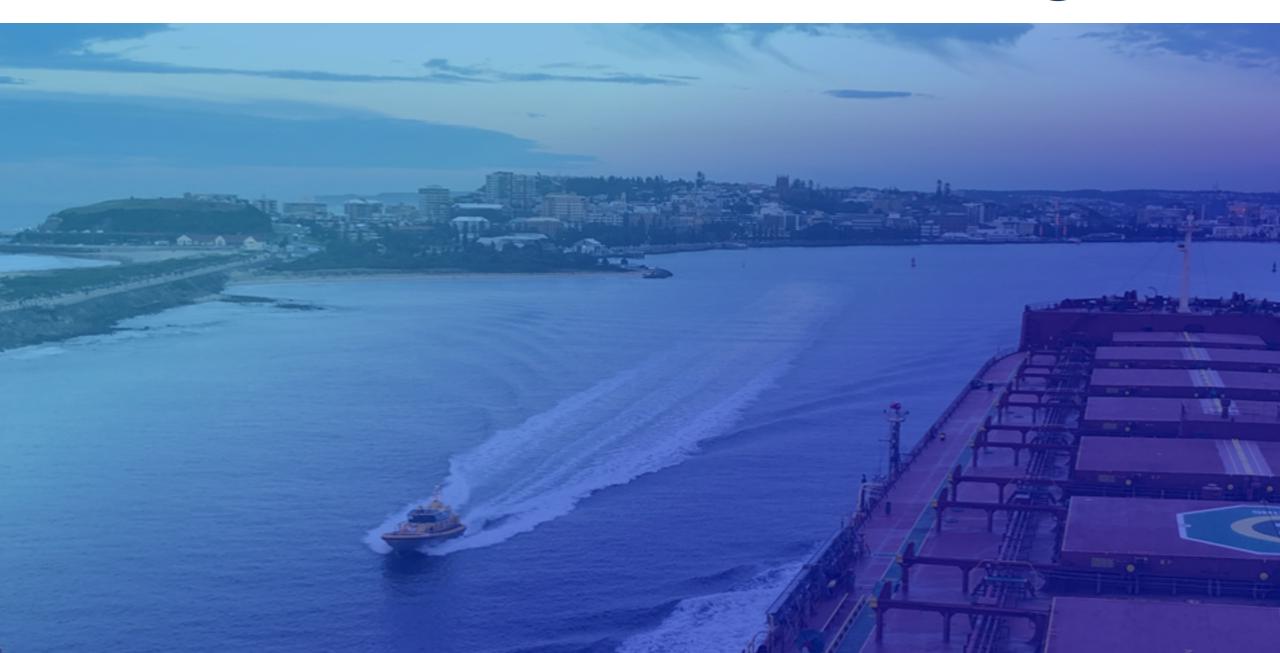

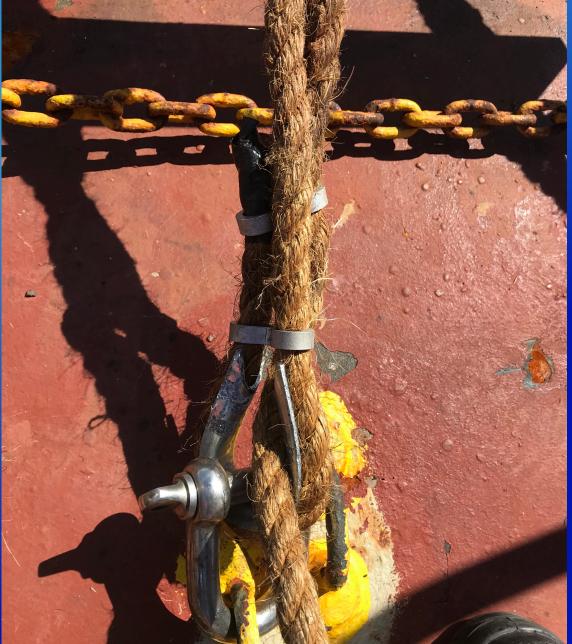

- Collaborating with Women in Maritime to assist with funding India's first woman pilot Reshma Nilofer to attend our 2019 conference.
- Arranging venues and catering for Women in Maritime/WISTA Events in parallel to our conferences.
- Including cadets, junior deck officers and other maritime trainees as guests at our conferences.
- Actively seeking a gender balance when developing event speaker programs.
- 2023 Conference we had approximately 200 delegates of those 15% of the pilots from around the world were women. We used sponsorship to assist with funding those who might not otherwise been able to attend.
- Funding trips to events focussed on women in the marine industry or other events we believe would be of benefit to the membership.
